Expectations

All Members are Expected to
Respect Yourself, Respect Others, Respect the Club and Club Property.
All members are responsible for your own belongings.

Rules

The following are not permitted:

1. Fighting Includes grabbing one another or playing / wrestling around
2. Profanity Includes condescending language or racial comments
3. Vandalism Includes vandalism on the facility, equipment, supplies and vehicles
4. Stealing Includes theft from the club, other members, staff and volunteers
5. Disrespect Includes disrespect to other members, staff and volunteers
6. Alcohol Includes any alcoholic beverages
7. Drugs Includes any illegal drugs
8. Tobacco Includes any form of tobacco
9. Bullying Includes verbal, physical, electronic, psychological

Use of Technology

Members will adhere to various policies when using electronic information resources. These policies include; not sharing passwords, not posting personal information of themselves or others, not trespassing into others files, not downloading unauthorized materials or software, not viewing inappropriate or unauthorized websites, not using the computer equipment to harm others or their work and not using these resources for commercial purposes. No cell phones, iPads, iPods or similar devices are to be used or visible while at the Club. Teenage members may be permitted use of certain devices at the discretion of the Club Director.

Dress Code

Inappropriate dress includes; visible undergarments, midriff-baring shirts or blouses, clothing with obscene or offensive language, graphics or logos, any item with gang identification, logos of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products or other prohibited substances. Shirts must be long enough to clearly overlap the belt line. Shoes should be closed toe.

Membership Suspension / Revocation

Members who do not follow the rules may be suspended and / or their membership may be revoked.
