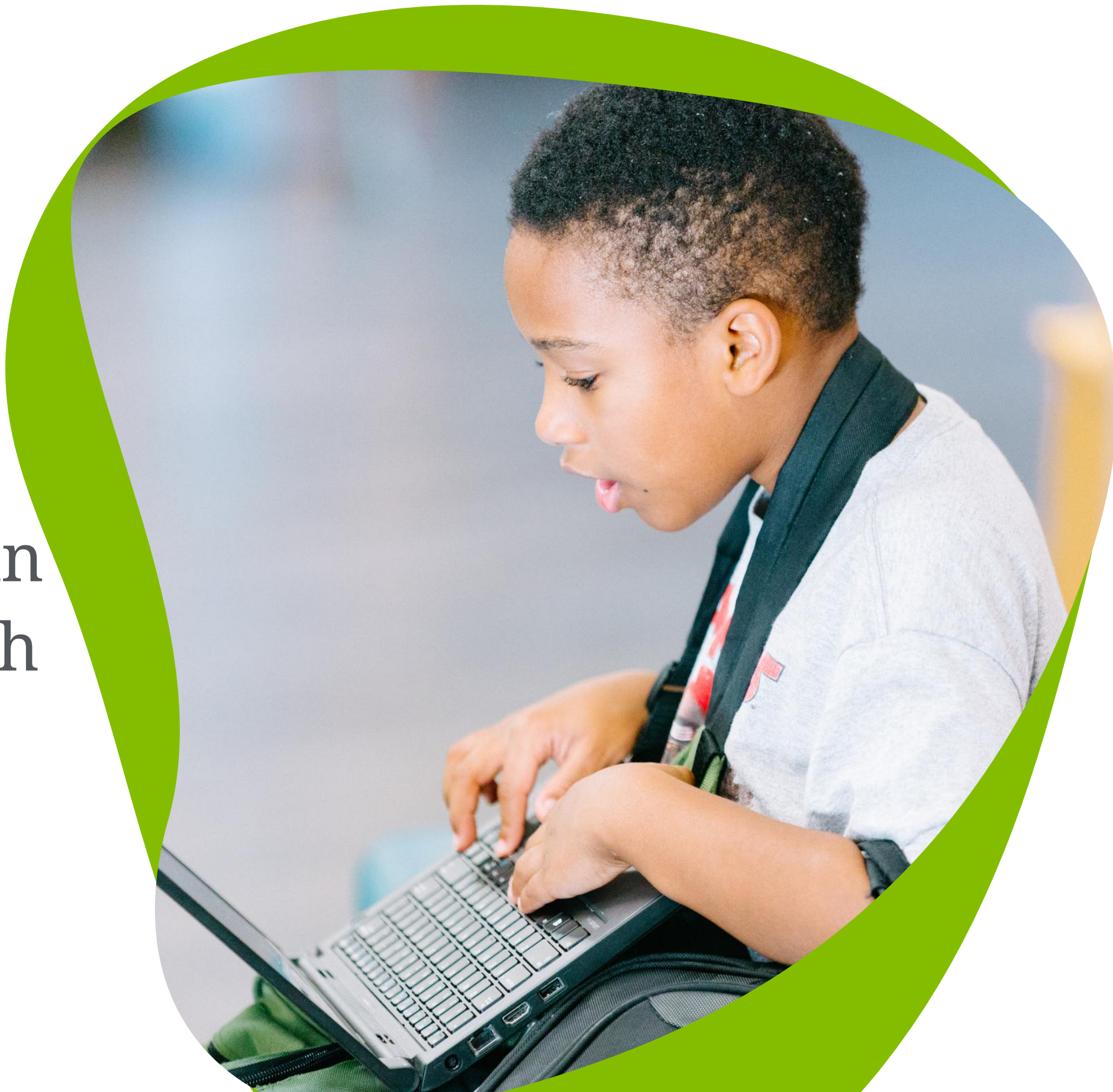

# SUMMER PROGRAM VOLUNTEERS

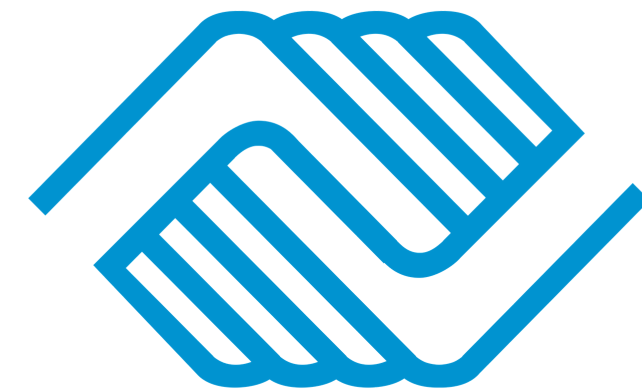
